## Notice to Exhibitors

Facsimile, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of AKC entry forms without "Agreement and Rules" on the reverse side of the entry form are not acceptable.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Please type or print the form clearly to avoid error. The United States Kerry Blue Terrier Club assume no responsibility for incomplete or inaccurate information on the entry form or for a dog being entered in a class for which he is not eligible.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or via e-mail by the Trial Secretary prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted after the entries have closed.

The United States Kerry Blue Terrier Club may decline any entry for cause or may remove any dog on account of sickness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee of \$25 will be added to the amount of any check returned.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event of 1) errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date, 2) the dog being absent, 3) the dog being disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition from the Trial Committee, 4) the dog having been entered incorrectly, 5) a bitch being in season.

All entries are to be mailed with the Fees to the Trial Secretary. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical after the closing date. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact Harry Wert at (203) 312-8186, or e-mail [carolandharry@prodigy.net](mailto:carolandharry@prodigy.net).

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agents are responsible for presenting their dog in the assigned ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Dogs need be at the trial only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates except when being judged.

All exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs. Those failing to do so will be subject to official action.

## Directions to the Trial

### From the Pennsylvania Turnpike:

Take PA Turnpike to Exit 339 (Fort Washington.)

Exit at Spring House, Norristown Road. Turn LEFT at light onto Norristown Road.

Drive 2 miles straight ahead to college on the right.

(Don't be concerned about the name change: Norristown Road becomes Sumneytown Pike after crossing over Bethlehem Pike at the Spring House intersection.)

### From Route 309 South:

Follow 309 South into Montgomeryville (approx. 45 min./1 hr. from Bethlehem.) Take Right onto 202 South.

(Montgomery Mall on your right and TGI Friday's on your right corner and Kinko's will be on your left.)

Follow 202 South to the 5th traffic light and turn LEFT onto Sumneytown Pike (William Penn Inn on your right.) Gwynedd-Mercy will be on your left (less than 1 mile.)

#### AGREEMENT

I (WE) ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE Rules Applying to Dog Shows and, if this entry is for an obedience trial, the Obedience Regulations, have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC-approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

[1] (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

[2] The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

[3] (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

[4] A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
