Twenty Basic Breeding Principles

There are a vast number of different breeding methods, some good, some bad. I should never presume to try to tell fanciers what is the right method because there is no such thing. Outstanding success can be achieved and has been achieved in a variety of different ways, so all I am going to do is to make some suggestions which I think helpful and to warn against certain pitfalls which trap too many of the unwary.


- Don't make use of indiscriminate outcrosses. A judicious outcross can be of great value, an injudicious one can produce an aggregation of every imaginable fault in the breed.
- Don't line breed just for the sake of line breeding. Line breeding with complementary types can bring great rewards; with unsuitable ones it will lead to immediate disaster.
- Don't take advice from people who have always been unsuccessful breeders. If their opinions were worth having they would have proved it by their success.
- Don't believe the popular cliché about the brother or sister of the great champion being just as good to breed from. For every one that is, hundreds are not. It depends on the animal concerned.
- Don't credit your own dogs with virtues they don't possess. Self-deceit is a stepping-stone to failure.
- Don't breed from mediocrities; the absence of a fault does not in any way signify the presence of its corresponding virtue
- Don't try to line breed two dogs at the same time; you will end by line breeding to neither.
- Don't assess the worth of a stud dog by his inferior progeny. All stud dogs sire rubbish at times; what matters are how good their best efforts are.
- Don't allow personal feelings to influence your choice of a stud dog. The right dog for your bitch is the right dog whoever owns it.
- Don't allow admiration of a stud dog to blind youto his faults. If you do you will soon be the victim of auto-intoxication.
- Don't mate together animals which share the same faults. You are asking for trouble if you do.
- Don't forget that it is the whole dog that counts. If you forget one virtue while searching for another you will pay for it.

- 13. Don't search for the perfect dog as a mate for your bitch. The perfect dog (or bitch) doesn't exist, never has or never will!
- 14. Don't be frightened of breeding from animals that have obvious faults so long as they have compensating virtues. A lack of virtue is far the greatest fault of all.
- 15. Don't mate together non-complementary types. An ability to recognize type at a glance is a breeder's greatest gift; ask the successful breeders to explain this subject - there is no other way of learning. (I would define non-complementary types as ones which have the same faults and lack the same virtues.)
- Don't forget the necessity to preserve head quality. It will vanish like a dream if you do.
- 17. Don't forget that substance plus quality should be one of your aims. Any fool can breed one without the other!
- 18. Don't forget that a great head plus soundness should be one of your aims. Many people can never breed either!
- 19. Don't ever try to decry a great Bull terrier. A thing of beauty is not only a joy forever but also a great pride and pleasure to all true lovers of the breed.
- 20. Don't be satisfied with anything but the best. The second best is never good enough.

Raymond H. Oppenheimer was a legendary Bull Terrier Breeder and a breed columnist in the English Dog World newspaper. His books, McGuffin & Co. and After Bar Sinister are still considered breed classics today.

Shear Agony!

Grooming Shears 101

You're ready to get serious about grooming your Kerry yourself. After watching the pros, whether they be the stylists at the local pet grooming shop, the professional show handlers, or fellow Kerry enthusiasts, you have decided to jump in and try your hand at it. It doesn't look that hard, in fact it looks like it could be fun. Plus, think of all the money you'll save...

Where do you start? In addition to the numerous decisions to make about what shampoo, conditioner, combs, brushes, dryers, clippers, and grooming table to buy, you must choose one of the most important tools in the groomer's arsenal: the grooming shear.

With so many to choose from, it can get quite confusing for someone just starting out. There are different materials, lengths, blade types, thumb hole configurations, and costs to consider. What may be suitable for one person, may be totally unacceptable for another.

First off, just like clothes, you must try on a few to see how they fit/feel before you'll want to shell out your money. And, they can get pricey-up to \$1,000 or more-though a good pair will generally run in the range of \$100-\$350, depending on material composition (440C is a good, basic steel grade commonly used) and workmanship. Some of the best places to look are at trade shows where there will be many scissor vendors with a large variety of models to try. Here, you will be able to hold the shears and see how they fit your hand. The vendor should be able to assist you with what to look for as far as balance (you don't want the shears to feel too end-heavy) and fit. People with larger hands and/or carpal tunnel issues may prefer an offset thumb hole as opposed to an evenly aligned (traditional) thumb/finger configuration. There are also crane handle and revolving thumb models available for added comfort.

The type of scissoring you'll be doing is very important when choosing your shears. A dog with a coarse or heavily matted coat will require a different type of shear than one that is soft, clean and completely brushed out. There are shears designed to plow through thick coats for "roughing out" and removing a lot of coat quickly, and there are those made exclusively for fine finishing on 100% tangle-free, squeaky clean coats. Cutting through mats and dirty coats, catching a toenail, or cutting too much hair at once with finishing shears will ruin them in no time by throwing them out of alignment and dulling the blades.

The first type of shear is also usually the most affordable. It has what is known as a "beveled" (or German) edge on the cutting blade, has a crisp, firm feel to the cut, and is generally good for newer groomers as it tends to grip the hair by incorporating micro-serrations on the edges. Typically heavier construction makes these shears durable and more "bomb proof," a good choice for beginners or groomers who tend to be heavy handed with their tools or groom many dogs in a day.

The second type of shear has what is referred to as a "convex" (or Japanese) cutting edge. Clamshell-shaped blades with a thin, razor-sharp outer cutting edge and a finely honed inside edge sharpened and polished to a mirror-like finish, they are very precise, smooth cutting, and cause less hand fatigue as a rule. They are also more fragile, expensive (usually), difficult to sharpen, and easily damaged by improper handling.

A good analogy (and apologies to the person plagiarized): think of a bevel edge as the four wheel drive pickup. It can drive anywhere and just about any mechanic can fix it. The convex edge is your Ferrari. It can't handle off-road driving, but it's sleek, smooth, and precise. A good mechanic is hard to find and more expensive.

A third type of edge, a semi-convex, is a hybrid of the two other types, and may be a good choice for those wishing for the control of a bevel with the added smoothness and finishing properties of a convex. An in-depth explanation of the three blade types can be found <u>here</u>. So which is best? For many of us, starting out with a good, durable pair of 8-8.5-inch beveled shears is the obvious choice. Scissoring skills take time to learn, though many talented, accomplished groomers prefer using these type of shears, even for fine finish work on show coats. Others may opt to use both types, or a combination of all three, depending on the job at hand. The important point is the type of shear needs to be appropriate for its intended use and user.

If you plan on trimming your dog once a month (or less) and keep your shears loose in a drawer, or if you have a habit of dropping things, you will want to steer clear of convex edges unless you enjoy buying new ones often. The innocent act of setting them down too abruptly on a hard surface can be enough to knock them out of alignment. On the other hand, if you are diligent about keeping your dog clean and groomed frequently, and are meticulous about maintaining your shears (oiled, wiped down and stored in a protective pouch), you may prefer the smoothness of a convex edge.

And, finally, once you get your new pair of grooming shears, take proper care of them. Use them only on clean, thoroughly combed-out dogs. Wipe the blades often with a soft cloth or chamois to remove excess hair and debris, and apply a small amount of scissor oil to the pivot point and set screw before placing them back into their protective holder or pouch. When it comes time to have them serviced or sharpened, be extremely careful of whom you entrust to perform this task. There are many so-called sharpeners out there equipped with grinding machines who don't possess the skill or knowledge to properly sharpen a quality pair of grooming shears, let alone the ability to meticulously hone the edges of a convex blade to factory specifications. It's a process that can't be done in just a couple minutes, and you WILL be able to tell the difference as soon as you use them. If done incorrectly, not only will the shears cut poorly, the destructive procedure will shorten the life of your highly precise, most dependable grooming tool. Oh, the agony!

Training the Kerry Blue Puppy

United States Kerry Blue Terrier Club Website - Training

The fastest and kindest way to house train a puppy is with the use of a wire crate. The crate becomes the puppy's safe and comfortable bed, and most puppies will make an effort to keep their bed clean. If the puppy is not accustomed to a crate, there may be a couple of difficult days at first, so line the crate with newspaper and shred more paper on top. The shredded paper will help keep the puppy clean in case of accidents. The crate is a home, not to be used as punishment!

In nature no young puppy is ever left alone in a strange place, and the puppy that screams the longest and the loudest in that situation is the one that is most likely to be found by his pack and will survive.

So, if you take a new puppy home and leave him alone overnight, you can expect that he will be awake all night and make a real mess of the area. If you take that same puppy and let him sleep in a crate beside your bed, he will feel safe and secure with his new pack leader (that's you) and sleeps through the night clean and quiet. Give him a raw hide toy to chew on, put him in the crate and go to bed yourself. Do not talk to the puppy or fuss over him. Most will quickly fall asleep. If he really persists in being restless, or wakes you up at night, take him out for a quick airing, but that is really unusual. First thing in the morning, pick the puppy up and carry him outside to the place you want him to use to relieve himself. With this method most puppies are clean and quiet through the night from the beginning. After the puppy is settled in and beginning to understand house training, you can move the crate somewhere else.

First thing in the morning or after a meal, take the puppy outside. Give him plenty of time to empty out, and just as he finishes relieving himself really give him a lot of praise. Applaud; cheer, rah, rah, what a clever puppy! This is how you explain to a dog that, yes; this is the place I want you to use. This is your positive reinforcement for correct behavior. Then ask, "are you ready to go in?" and occasionally a dog may, in effect, say wait a minute, and make one more puddle. When you take the puppy indoors, and you are pretty sure he is empty, you may allow him to run free in the room with you, or keep him with you on a lead as you work around the house.

The puppy will play and explore for a while and then settle down to chew on a toy or to nap. When the puppy wakes up or becomes restless, take him out again immediately. Puppies have a very limited capacity for waiting.

Each time you prevent a mistake by getting the puppy out at the right time and each time the puppy eliminates outdoors, you are reinforcing the correct behavior and the puppy's natural instinct to keep his home clean.

The time will come when the puppy relieves himself and looks to you expecting praise, proof that the puppy is beginning to understand where the "correct place" is. Until this happens you should never, never, make any correction for mistakes indoors. Just clean up and say nothing. If you make too tough a correction before the puppy understands what is wanted, he may be frightened and simply never do anything when you are nearby. This is what has happened to

most older dogs that are not house-trained. Even when the puppy is obviously getting the idea and being clean most of the time, you should be careful to avoid overdoing the corrections. You should see progress each week even though there might be a few mistakes along the way.

If someone is home most of the time and really paying attention to the puppy, he should be well trained in a month. If no one is home during the day, you will be lucky to have the puppy trained by six months of age simply because the puppy is not physically capable of waiting that many hours. Can you wait all day? It will speed up the process immensely if you can get someone to take the puppy out in the middle of the day. Just keeping a puppy outdoors doesn't help because he is not learning to wait and to keep certain areas clean.

When you are too busy to pay attention to the puppy, when you have to leave the house for a while, exercise the puppy and then put him in the crate and go about your business. Ignore the puppy. He should be used to spending some time in the crate every day.

Kerries have a wonderful barometer on their rear ends, the tail! If you catch the fellow chewing on a chair leg and you tell him "no", and the tail stays up and he goes right back to chewing, you know that that correction was not severe enough for that dog. If on the other hand the tail goes down and stays down, you over-did it a bit. Should a dog pick up a piece of laundry you dropped, a mild "no" would probably be appropriate.

Don't use the same correction for minor things that you would use for something major.

If you crate the puppy when you are too busy to keep an eye on him, the puppy will not be learning -destructive habits, and prevention is much more effective than corrections. As the puppy becomes more civilized, you may gradually increase the time he is left unsupervised. At the first sign of chewing or soiling, go back a few steps and use the crate.

Almost all pet owners give the puppy too much freedom too soon, which fosters the formation of difficult habits.

It is not uncommon for a puppy that seems well trained to go through another chewing stage as an adolescent. Just use the crate and closer supervision again. Dog breeders often house-train several new puppies each year, and with the help of a crate, their houses survive with less damage than most pet owners have with one puppy.

The surest way to bond a puppy to one person, if he is supposed to be Suzy's dog for instance, would be for him to sleep beside Suzy's bed and for her to begin basic obedience training the day after the puppy arrives.



A Word from Charitable Funds...

As many of you know the US Kerry Blue Charitable Fund was established in 2002. Its purpose was to serve the Kerry Blue Terrier in four important areas:

1) Rescue Fund – this fund supports grants used to provide Kerry Blue Terrier rescue services.

2) Health and Genetics Fund - this fund makes grants in support of research in areas of health and genetics of particular importance to the Kerry Blue Terrier.

3) Education Fund – the education fund supports education of all those interested in the Kerry Blue Terrier including publications, websites, and seminars.

4) General Fund – donations to this fund are used to support the work of the other funds through internal grants to those funds. Undesignated gifts will initially be held in this fund.

Since the Fund was established we have worked diligently to build the assets of the Funds while undertaking major support of the PNA Research being done at the University of Missouri. This is quite impressive, since our Fund is relatively new compared to other Parent Clubs whose equivalent organizations are often decades older than ours.

Our current objective is to continue to grow fund assets while undertaking occasional substantial support such as the PNA Grant. We believe the real key to long term growth will be planned giving that includes the Funds in the wills of our members. Other comparable organizations have used this method as the key to growing their assets. The reality is that we must grow our financial resources substantially in order to having a meaningful impact and that means it will take many years to be in a position to have a significant impact on our core areas.



Dear fellow USKBTC members,

I would like to thank to our club president, Mr. John Garahan, Dr. Scott Kellogg and the rest of our Board for the honor and the privilege of serving as a Head of USKBTC Health and Genetics committee for year 2015. I shall try to serve you to the best of my ability, to promote out wonderful breed and further the interests of our Club and the Kerry enthusiasts it represents.

To further introduce myself, I am a Small Animal Veterinarian and a Kerry owner. I graduated the University of Veterinary Medicine in former Czechoslovakia in 1998. Following the externship at Washington State University, I worked in the United States in general as well as emergency veterinary practice till 2010.







Family & Pet Friendly Gardens & Lawns By Susan Dunivant

Summer in most areas of the country and particularly the humid south always brings the expected perennial challenges to the home gardener and pet owner. There are a number of toxins which may lurk in our dog's environment of which we may not be aware. But with a little research and the incentive of health for ourselves and our dogs spurring us to ask a few questions, our gardens and Kerry Blues will thrive through the summer months.

There are a number of pesticides that are commonly used by yard/garden maintenance services, as well as fertilizers which may not be the best choice for homes with small children or pets. Before agreeing to any yard/garden maintenance contract, we should sit down with the representative and get a full schedule of the services and what chemicals they intend to use on our property. Questions about toxicity and length of potency should be asked and if there are safer substitutes for any of the chemicals they may use. It's also very important to make it clear that they should report ANY changes in the chemicals they use and that these should be cleared first before applying to the lawn or garden.

Many enjoy doing their own yard/garden maintenance. The Internet is of course a treasure trove of information, some a bit too hysterical in warnings, others too blasé, but there are those sites which approach the subject in a sensible well-reasoned manner. Read them all, then decide a course of action. There are many times when one can avoid an "overkill" situation AND save a little cash.

Not only must we concern ourselves with what we put on our yards or gardens, but we should be aware of what toxic plants may be growing. There are certain plants which can be anywhere from mildly toxic to lethal for man or beast and it's a good idea to familiarize ourselves with those. Having said this, there are also "myths" about some plants which paint them as villains when in reality they are only mildly toxic or harmless, while other plants we think are innocent may be very toxic to our pets. Wild mushrooms or "toad stools" are to be considered toxic until a mycologist can identify them as otherwise. Even then a mushroom safe for human ingestion may not be safe for a dog. Make a habit of patrolling your property and pulling up and disposing of any mushrooms or identifiable toxic plants.

Also be aware of landscaping material you use in your dog's environment. There is a type of mulch called "100% natural Cocoa mulch" which might seem a great choice for the gardener who wishes to be environmentally friendly. Yet this mulch when ingested has resulted in serious illness and even death in dogs. Again, we should make a habit of doing a little research before making the trip to the garden center.

The question could be, "So what do I use on my yard to control pests or fertilize?" Again, there are chemical and


organic fertilizers which are safe to use around small children and animals. Everything can be broken down into some organic or chemical formula which if read on an ingredient label might be unrecognizable as an ordinary component in many things we use every day. Although we needn't pursue a degree in organic chemistry, a little research will reveal much of what we need to know on that pesticide bottle.

But more and more the home gardener is turning to a new but really very ancient arsenal of treatments for pests of all kinds. Rather than soaking a flea infested yard with a possibly dangerous chemical we can now choose to use beneficial nematodes to eradicate the pests. It is important to choose the right nematode for the job and there are several excellent sites which have information along with product to treat flea problems as well as other insect pests. This is a favorite of mine, an online store site of the Nitron Company: Garden IQ

Not only does this site (and others like it) offer pest control, but they offer "friendly" fertilizers and other items a home gardener will find useful for a beautiful yard while maintaining a healthy environment besides.

Summer is a wonderful time of the year to enjoy with family and pets. Rolling around on a lush green lawn or working in our gardens with our dogs and children rank among the great joys of life. With a little preplanning and attention to labels and plant descriptions, we can insure our beautiful lawns and gardens are family and dog friendly.

Bone Broth

While bone broth isn't nutritionally complete for exclusive long term feeding, you can use it as a base for a complete meal or as a supplement for your dog's regular diet. Bone broth is a healthy way to moisten dry food, hydrate your dog when he's sick, and you can even share it with your dog and reap the same benefits! Make bone broth a regular part of your cooking repertoire year round.

There is no magic time, but try simmering it for 24 hours in a crockpot. You could do it on the stove as well, but be sure you don't leave the simmering broth unattended.

You can use raw or cooked bones but be sure to include joint bones with cartilage. You can collect and save cooked bones from your own meals in the freezer but be sure to rinse any sauce off that may be irritating to your dog's digestive system. Turkey wings and legs are a good raw choice.

Completely cover the bones with water; add raw apple cider vinegar or lemon juice, which helps draw the minerals out of the bones more thoroughly and makes a more

nutritious broth. Cover by about two inches of water, but not too much more, to keep the broth dense. For a regular sized crockpot, use about two to four tablespoons apple cider vinegar. Turn your crockpot to high just to get it started for the first hour, then switch to low and let it go for the day.

When your broth is finished, strain the bones ~ do **NOT** feed these to your dog! If you used bones with meat attached you'll need to strip them by hand. Once it's chilled, skim the excess fat off the top of the broth if you wish (there may be less than you expect). The remainder is your broth. If it has a jelly--like consistency when it's cold you've done a good job of it!

You can freeze this broth in small containers (even ice cube trays) for easy dispensing. Or you can store it in your refrigerator for about four days.



De-Skunking by Maryanne Schaefer

Loss of habitat is forcing more and more wildlife into populated areas, so even if you are a city dweller, your dog may encounter a skunk. There are several products on the market made specifically for removing skunk spray. Two such products are "Nature's Miracle Skunk Odor Remover" by Nature's Miracle, and "Skunk Off" by Thornwell Corporation.

Some suggestions for bathing a dog who has skunk odor:

Before handling your dog, you may want to change your clothes. Skunk spray is very difficult to remove from clothing. Cover the dog's bed with something to protect it. Leaving the dog outdoors for a while will greatly reduce the odor.

Determine where the spray hit the dog. Depending on your dog's hair type, you may be able to trim away or comb out some of the affected hair.

When you're ready to wash the dog, only clean the sprayed area. Skunk spray is oily and can easily be spread all over the dog. Since you will likely have to repeat the procedure, save an all-over bath until the second or third washing.

Editor's Note:

In a recent article (December 2003) of "Your Dog" newsletter published by Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine, they suggested a safe home treatment for de-skunking your dog.

Wash the dog with the following mixture: One-fourth of a cup of baking soda One teaspoon of liguid soap One quart of hydrogen peroxide

Blueprints Editor's Note: I have personally used the mixture recommended by Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine, and can report that it worked very well for us!



Favorite Dog Biscuits

3 cups whole wheat flour 2 cups multi-grain oatmeal or old-fashioned oats 1/4 cup wheat germ 1/4 cup nonfat dry milk powder 1 1/4 cup water 1 large egg 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder Peanut butter to taste

Adjust oven rack in the lower third of oven and preheat to 275° F. Line baking sheet with parchment paper. Toss the flour, oats, wheat germ and powdered milk in a large bowl to blend thoroughly. Mix water, peanut butter and egg in a food processor or blender until smooth. Add garlic to dry ingredients, then add all dry ingredients into wet ingredients and stir until blended. Dough will be stiff, so use your hands to roll or pat dough into a 1/2 inch thickness. Cut out biscuit shapes with 3-inch bone shaped cutter. Continue, rerolling left over dough and cutting biscuits until dough is gone. Place cookies on baking sheet and bake for a bout 90 minutes. For crispier, drier biscuits bake for a total of 3 hours. Store well dried biscuits in an airtight container.



Categories of Awards:

1. Category 1 -Service Dog:

Service or assistance dogs are trained to assist individuals with meeting special needs on a daily basis; these needs can be physical, psychological and/or emotional; examples include hearing, sight service dogs and alert response dogs who alert their human companions to seizures and other medical emergencies;

2. Category 2 - Therapy Dog:

Therapy dogs are trained to provide care and comfort to patients and residents in medical care facilities, retirement communities and shelters; Examples include retirement communities; senior centers; veterans homes, military hospitals; healthcare facilities, hospitals, hospice and medical care facilities; children's hospitals, rehabilitation centers such as shelters for homeless, battered women and children; military and veterans hospitals and recovery centers for wounded soldiers.

3. Category 3 -Educational Service/Therapy Dog :

Educational Service Dogs or therapy dogs work with children in public and private schools in academic and special needs areas; Programs can include but are not limited to the Bite Avoidance programs in schools and organizations such as The Boys and Girls Clubs; Canine-Assisted Reading Programs in Schools and Libraries; Safety School Crossing Program; Programs include Kerries teaching children how to interact with dogs and build a positive relationship with dogs;

4. Category 4 -Exemplary Companion Dog /Act of Exemplary Performance:

The Exemplary Companion Dog is the Kerry who has performed a one time event of an exemplary act, contributed to others or a Kerry who has exhibited companionship to an individual under exemplary circumstances (Example: saving family members from a fire in the home or acted as a companion to a person who is terminally ill;) Other examples of exemplary performance include Kerries who serve in search and rescue, or work with military, firefighters and police in security and rescue.

Award Criteria:

- 1. The dog must be a purebred Kerry Blue Terrier;
- The dog must be nominated by a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition; the owner(s) of the dog does not need to be a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition;

Award:

 Each qualified recipient who contributes in one area receives a Level I Certificate and Medallion; Contributions in two areas received a Level II Certificate and Medallion and those who contribute in three areas receive a Level III Certificate and Medallion.

Recognition:

 Each recipient will be recognized in Blueprints; on the USKBTC website, and at their local specialty of choice, if desired and requested.

United States Kerry Blue Terrier Club Versatility Awards

The mission of this awards program is to recognize the versatility of the Kerry Blue Terrier and recognize United States Kerry Blue Terrier members and their dogs upon achieving titles in more than one discipline of competition. Current USKBTC membership is necessary to be eligible for this awards program.

List of Disciplines eligible for awards (including minimum title requirements, where applicable):

AKC Agility Title A novice-level standard or jumpers title (regular or preferred)

AKC Conformation Title CH or higher

Earth Dog/Hunting Title: Hunting Certificate (HC) awarded by American Working Terrier Association, or the Barn Hunt Association's RATN or higher

Herding Trial Dog Title: AKC Herding Tested (HT) or Pre-Trial Tested (PT), or the Herding Capability Title (HCT) awarded by American Herding Breeds Association

AKC Obedience Title CD or higher

AKC Tracking Title TD or higher

AKC Rally Title RN or higher

Miscellaneous: A novice-level or higher performance or working title from a discipline not otherwise listed may be used for one of the award levels, subject to approval. Examples include Flyball, Canine Nosework, AKC Coursing Ability and Therapy Dog titles, and Dock Dog.

Eligible dogs will be submitted for award(s) by owner(s) in the following manner: Properly filled in application including:

- Enclosure or email attachment of a copy of non-AKC titles as needed for verification.
 - (For Platinum Level and above) Comments or brief biography of dog's accomplishments which will be published in the Blueprints (subject to editing) along with award presented, including name of owner(s) and breeder(s). Photos sent by owner for inclusion in *Blueprints* will be printed subject to room available.

Award applications will be accepted within the following one year time period: September 1 to August 31st. Members will submit applications during this time period. Any applications received after August 31st will be held over for the next year for qualification and presentation. Award presentation will be made at the Annual General Meeting in October (Montgomery County). Awards not presented at the AGM will be mailed to recipients.

ACTUAL AWARD: The award will be a certificate suitable for framing signed by the president of the club and Versatility committee representative to include the following information:

- The name: United States Kerry Blue Terrier Club Versatility Award
- The name of the Award tier (see below)
- The registered name of the dog (with all titles, as the owner wishes it to appear on award)

The names of the owner(s) of record (at least ONE owner must be a current USKBTC member) and the breeder(s) of record. The date the Award is presented

ONE certificate will be presented per dog for each award tier.

A keepsake memento commemorating the award will be awarded at the club's discretion.

Award tier structure is as follows:

The Bronze Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in two different disciplines.

The Silver Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in three different disciplines.

The Gold Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in four different disciplines.

The Platinum Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in five different disciplines.

The Emerald Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in six different disciplines. The Diamond Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in seven different disciplines.

The Blue Diamond Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles all seven listed disciplines, plus at least one Miscellaneous title.

* Please Note: Canine Good Citizen (CGC), Temperament Testing (TT), and Therapy Dog International (TDI) along with other therapy or service dog certifications, with the exception of AKC's Therapy Dog (THD) title, are not considered working titles. Therefore they do not qualify as eligible disciplines for these awards. These certifications may however be included in the dog's name as stated on a Versatility Award should the owner wish them. The owner is responsible for submitting the dog's name as it should appear on the award. Members wanting their Kerries' therapy or service dog accomplishments recognized are encouraged to apply for the USKBTC's "Kerry It Forward" awards.

Additional Notes: The accomplishment of any of these disciplines may take more than one calendar year to achieve. Therefore the applicant may submit an application along with proof of awards at any time provided that the owner submits the application by the stated deadline to qualify for that year's award presentations. A separate award and certificate will be awarded for each additional discipline tier achieved no matter what time frame is required to achieve that award. Example: Dog A is already a Ch., CDX, TD. Therefore he will immediately qualify under (3) disciplines (conformation, obedience, tracking) making the dog eligible to receive (2) awards (Bronze and Silver) from the club. To be eligible, awards must be applied for within 5 years of the last title being earned.
