

# Agility Foundation Training - Let the fun begin!

I've been competing in the sport of agility since 1995, so when Topper joined our family 5 years ago, I already knew I wanted to play the game of agility with him one day. Some of you have seen my YouTube videos of Topper riding his skateboard, balancing on a boogie board in the water, or performing a variety of tricks. These might seem like "parlor tricks" or silly things for a dog to do, but there was a purpose from the very start. These behaviors were taught to Topper before beginning any formal agility training, and most were trained with our agility goal in mind. Since agility is a sport that involves speedy handling through a course of obstacles, it's understandable that you may be wondering what any of these have to do with agility at all! My answer: More than you think! There is so much that simple foundation training can contribute to your success in this fun team sport before you even begin obstacle training! Agility is not all about the obstacles...

So, what are some of the things that I personally like to teach before (or during) basic agility training with my dogs? I put together a list of five of the things that are important to me. (There are others, but these are a good start.) This training can be done at any age, tiny puppy through adulthood, but if you have a puppy there is no reason to wait, start right away! These skills will easily transfer to anything you want to do with your Kerry and are not limited to agility enthusiasts by any means! I am convinced that Topper's foundation from the list below even contributed to his success in the conformation ring.

My list of five skills important to agility foundation training:
Shaping & Love to Learn
Self Control & Focus
Tricks & Games
Retrieving & Tugging
Body Awareness

Shaping & Love to Learn - I like to use a clicker to introduce my dogs to training. Clickers have been around for awhile now, and are an excellent tool to teach dogs to think, problem-solve, and discover that it is fun to learn and train with you. One of my favorite uses of the clicker is "shaping." Shaping involves being patient and waiting for your dog to offer a behavior. When you see something you like, mark it with a click followed by a treat. While you can always say a word such as "yes" instead of using a clicker, the clicker gives better precision and a unique sound unlike anything else to mark the instant the dog does what you are looking for. Shaping is useful in training because you want your dog to be able to think on his own and offer behaviors. What you do is let them know when they are on the right track, which keeps them trying. No click? Try something else. Click and treat? Yes, that's it! The dogs are having fun, all the while rewarded for offering approximations of the end result, a win-win for everyone. An added bonus is that

this transfers to a love of working with you. There are many resources for clicker training on the Internet, such as Karen Pryor's website (www.clickerdogs.com). Karen Pryor's "101 Things To Do With A Box" is an easy and fun exercise to begin shaping. The key to shaping is not to help too much. If your dog gets stuck or quits offering, make it easier until he is successful, then stop and have a party! We want our dogs to learn to think for themselves, and shaping exercises provide a true learning experience for both dog and handler.

Self Control & Focus – This is a subject near and dear to everyone who does performance with their dog, but especially important in the intensely exciting atmosphere of an agility trial. In agility it's helpful to have a dog with a solid start line stay so you can lead out to an advantageous position before releasing your dog. My dogs must sit before they are let out of their crates, allowed to go out the back door, before eating, chasing a ball, etc. You are only limited by your imagination in what control behaviors you want to establish, but these are a good start and do transfer to agility training if you stick with it!

Your dog needs to be able to think and focus on you in a highly charged environment. I had to work on this for a long time with Topper. When he was a young dog accompanying me and Niki to agility trials he would get so *stimulat*-

ed when he saw dogs doing contact obstacles or tunnels (those "things" he loves so much) that he would actually scream. My approach to getting him acclimated



involved moving him far enough away from the action that he could be reasonably calm and respond to my requests for simple behaviors (such as a hand touch, sit or down). Then slowly moving closer and rewarding him for being calm and attentive to me. While not every dog has this "problem" this is one we had to work on from the very beginning, even when I was training Niki in my own backyard! I have used similar training to acclimate my dogs to being close to unfamiliar dogs tugging and being jazzed up by their handlers outside the agility ring, not an unusual occurrence at agility trials.

<u>Tricks & Games</u> – This is related to love of learning, but involves teaching specific "trick" behaviors and fun games to play with your dog. Tricks and games become rewarding in themselves. Some of the tricks I've taught my dogs include: hand touch, back up, handstand, beg, crawl backwards,

crawl forwards, weave between my legs, backwards weaving, foot walking (dog between my legs, we walk forward with his front feet on top of my feet), jump up, bow, smack my feet, high five, and others. Some of the games we play include Monster Hand, I'm Gonna Getcha, 360 Spins, and Follow Me. Most of you probably have some special "games" that your dog loves to play, so just start using these



when you're training. Basically any tricks or games can be used to keep your dog engaged when you are training, waiting your turn to

run, or setting up on the start line to get focus. A regular start line routine that your dog is familiar with that includes some easy tricks or games is a great way to get the focus you need right before you run! Teaching tricks can be useful anywhere! I even used tricks in the conformation ring to keep my dog "up" during the down time when the judge was going over other dogs. There are lots of resources for trick training on the Internet, and some good trick training books and videos available as well.

Retrieving & Tugging - Retrieving and tugging have great potential for the sport of agility. Why? Both involve cooperation and interaction between dog and handler. These are easiest to teach to a young puppy in a confined space. For retrieving, if your puppy has a potential for running off with toys, you can attach a light line to the toy. I started out with a ball or toy in a small indoor space and rewarded Topper with a treat when he "caught" the object and brought it back to me. Most dogs love to tug, but sometimes it's harder to get them to tug after getting used to food rewards. The toy can be made interesting with quick movements away from the dog (imagine it's a squirrel) and physical engagement during tugging. If he lets go you get to play with the toy by yourself; that's guaranteed to spark his interest! Don't forget to let your dog win the prize once in awhile. After tugging has some value for your dog it's time to introduce rules of play such as how to begin and end the game, and releasing the toy. Then you can incorporate control behaviors (start the game, ask for a quick sit, then reward with another tugging session). Tugging is especially useful to get dogs "ready" and focused to work or as a reward after you run. In training, in addition to getting your dog eager to play, you can toss the tug toy as a reward as he completes weave poles or a line of jumps. We want a retrieve so he brings the toy back to you!

Body Awareness – This is the fun stuff for me and my dogs. They love interacting with things, and the best part about it is that this quickly transfers to agility equipment. Early on I introduce all kinds of objects to my puppy. Wobble board (36x36 square board with a tennis ball attached underneath), balancing on an exercise ball, riding a skateboard, surfing on a boogie board, walking front feet ("dribbling") on a basketball, pivoting on stepstools and other objects, stepping into a dog bowl with all four feet, running to the end of a 4' plank, backing up stair steps and through ladders...the list goes on. Do you remember shaping? That's how I taught most of these activities to my dogs. When Topper was young I bought a skateboard for him and introduced it by shaping with a clicker. To train this, first stabilize the skateboard so that it doesn't move or frighten your puppy. Click for interest in the skateboard, a touch with nose or paw, and continue to shape in tiny increments until your puppy is standing on the board. At that point you can try some controlled, very slow movement. Eventually let your puppy experiment moving the board on his own. Always go at your puppy's pace, don't rush it, and you may have a skateboarder of your own!

There's a big word for body awareness in athletic training: *proprioception*. This is described as "one's own orientation of one's limbs in space." Think about what dogs need to do in agility. Dogs run at full speed over the Dogwalk con-

structed by boards that are only 12" wide, and made out of three sections; two ends slanted and the middle board 4 feet high in the air. They need excellent hind end awareness and confidence



to perform this obstacle. There are Weave Poles which are the most unnatural of all agility obstacles for dogs. To weave, they must hop back and forth between a set of 12 poles like a slalom skier all the way to the end. Most other agility obstacles involve running, jumping climbing, or burrowing which are natural activities for most dogs. Good body awareness is a necessity for agility dogs and their longevity in the sport. I should also mention that in my efforts to keep up with Topper & Niki on the agility field and be the handler they deserve, I've taken up running for exercise, and now find myself in the best athletic shape I've been in years! This just goes to show that agility is a fun and healthy sport for both dogs and people!

But... the most important part is that my dogs love to be with me... no matter what we do. Whether we are having a relaxing evening on the sofa, taking a long walk, playing

ball, working on exercise balls, going to an obedience or agility class, or stepping to the line in an agility competition... I believe that the bond we have developed through training fun games and activities has contributed to their happy attitude, willingness and excitement to work with me at any given moment. When we go out to train they are ears & tails up, eyes bright, ready to go. This is the joyful attitude I hope to see in my dogs.

I've been hooked on agility since 1995 when I started with Toby, my third Kerry, who was also the first dog I ever trained or showed in a performance event. Of my current



dogs, Niki, an 11-1/2 year old Lakeland Terrier, is close to getting her MACH4 and she's also been the #1 Agility Lakie since 2007. Topper, a 5


year old Kerry, started his agility career in late October 2010, and just achieved his first MACH in April 2012.

Having fun in agility is within the reach of anyone who enjoys getting out and doing things with their dog. There are so many performance sports available to our dogs now compared to when I first started. Some basic and fun foundation training could give you a head start for agility or any other sport you might want to try with your beautiful, athletic, Kerry. Go out and have some fun!

#### Pet Therapy with Hospice...

When asked to write an article about how we became involved with Hospice Pet Therapy, all I can really say is... it found us... and has changed us forever.

While at a school football game last October, I was approached by a local dog trainer that had heard of my kid's dog show experiences and had witnessed Jack greeting kids after school. She shared news of her new pet therapy program she was launching for our local Hospice organization and was trying to recruit potential therapy dogs. I could hardly keep focused on the details of her conversation; my mind kept drifting as I knew Jack would be a great candidate—he has always been a southern gentleman!

For those not familiar, Hospice is a special healthcare option for patients and families who are faced with a terminal illness. A multi-disciplinary team of physician, nurses, social workers, bereavement counselors and volunteers works together to address the physical, social, emotional and spiritual needs of each patient and family. The hospice team provides care to patients in their own home or a home-like setting regardless of the patient's age or ability to pay. So, needless to say, our 'new friends' aren't with us long and our time and experiences with them are generally their final memories.

After the excitement of being invited to participate in this program, it hit me that this was a very serious life topic and I wasn't so sure I was equipped to handle it-especially with my 16-year old daughter. Putting all fears aside, I registered 'Jack' and McKenna for the training class and my daughter was pretty insistent that I join her in this adventure, so I agreed to take Sophie along and see if she would be a candidate, thinking this might be fun to do together as a mother/daughter team. (Little did she know I needed her moral support more than she needed mine.)

After completing the class, both dogs and handlers passed with flying colors and were certified and registered with TDI. The process is lengthy and thorough, but if the dogs are true therapy material, it is not a difficult process at all. Therapy work really isn't something you can TRAIN your dog to do-- they either have it, or they don't. For us, in addition to TDI or Delta requirements, Hospice required further training which involved a more advanced and in-depth testing of both dogs. Hospice trained dogs work with very fragile people in their last days of life, so they are trained to withstand the sounds of medical equipment, smells of chemicals/cleaners, taught simple commands like 'head down' where they place their head on a lap or bed and be still to allow for petting. They need to be slow to move and cautious of IV tubes and drains while laying on beds, and they must also be very accustomed to walking next to moving wheelchairs and walkers and not be frightened or jump on the patients while they are sitting. Also, the dog should have a fairly high pain tolerance, as the residents will

grab and pull and sometimes hug much too tight. It could be an horrific experience if the dog responded to pain by biting or clawing at someone.

All I can say is...there is nothing we learned in class that can prepare you for 'the work'. Our first assignment was to visit an elderly lady and, with me not very comfortable with the aging process, I will admit, I was terrified. A million red flags were coming to mind and I was beginning to wonder if I had made a horrible decision to bring my daughter into this experience. Death and dying is such an uncomfortable topic



of discussion for most people, and all I could think about was...'what condition would our patient be in when we arrived', or 'how would Jack react to her', or 'would he behave and remember his training'...or, 'would he poop somewhere'!! A hundred negative scenarios were racing through my head and my hands were sweating as we walked into the entrance. And for those that know my daughter, she was chatty that day-talking profusely is not a typical behavior for her! Jack was the only one that acted somewhat cool and collected and he led us into the building-- it's like he knew he needed to take charge and have the confidence we lacked.

We first greeted an eagerly awaiting family and when we approached our patient's bed, soon discovered she was much closer to death than we had imagined, but she had communicated that she loved dogs and was looking forward to meeting Jack. (Hospice had put out a 'directory' of their therapy dogs into a picture book with a description of each dog. This is a helpful tool for families in selecting dogs that they want to have visit, so they already knew about Jack and had selected him.) We talked and listened and left feeling very good about our visit...it was very clear, our visit had made their day. If they only really knew, it made OUR day, too!

Not but a few days later, we received a call from our Hospice director and she indicated our patient friend had taken a terrible turn for the worse...and she was on her deathbed. Her last request was to have her 'teddy bear' dog by her side when she passed. Being so new to therapy work, our director was reluctant to even call on us and said we didn't have to go if we didn't feel comfortable. In my head, all I could think about was how could we NOT go?! This woman's dying wish was to see Jack again...

This was a very emotional day for McKenna and I and we didn't have too many words to share during the ride home, but, as we pulled in the driveway, I knew all was good when McKenna asked me when we would go again. This has definitely been a sobering life experience and can put the everyday drama of life in complete perspective.

Since then, McKenna and I have made home visitations and many trips to area nursing centers to visit folks in Hospice and other residents in group therapy settings. We do individual visits where we bring only our dogs, but we enjoy the Pet Therapy team visits where we travel as a group to the centers for visitation. Jack and Sophie are the only KBTs but they draw the most attention and are the topic of chatter amongst the residents and staff. Everyone asks of us, "do they have eyes under that hair?" ... and ... "how did you get them to stand so high on their toes?" One lady even asked where he goes to get his hair done because she 'liked his jheri curl'! People are so funny!

The dogs make a huge difference in the routine day of the resident and the health care worker. In the months that we have been actively working, I have seen a growing interest in our visitation. We always call ahead and inform the center we will be coming and schedule a day and time. We ask that anyone mobile and interested in receiving pet therapy be waiting together for us in a room where we can visit. By doing this, we do not force our dogs on those not wishing to be disturbed or perhaps are afraid of dogs. When we first started visiting, there were maybe three or four people waiting--now the room is always full! It is literally wheelchair to wheelchair and difficult to maneuver the dogs in and around those that want to pet and hold them. We giggle about traffic jams and 'back-up beepers' as the residents try to go from dog to dog. We finally have insisted they stay put and we come to them. We hear cries from the crowd: "Jack-Jack! Come here, boy!" and he doesn't know where to go first and leaves there completely exhausted from all the attention. I think word has gotten out about the dogs visiting and during my last visit we pulled three guys from maintenance and grounds keeping off their job! Everyone can benefit from the therapeutic value of a sweettempered, plush Kerry Blue and the staff have indicated how much they look forward to the dog visits as it breaks up the seriousness of their day, too.

Once Sophie has recovered from 'motherhood', I look forward to getting her actively involved in therapy work again. I bred her not long after she graduated so I look forward to seeing her 'at work'. Her temperament is more playful and toy-driven than Jack, and it has been recommended that she and I visit the Ronald McDonald house where we can spend time with siblings of sick children and entertain them. She is also being considered for the Oncology department of our local hospital; with her non-shedding coat, she can entertain the kids while they sit for treatment. So, we are hard at work practicing some new tricks and have some doozies up our sleeve! She is a funny and animated Kerry and I think she will keep them all laugh-

ing with her antics. Laughter is the best medicine, right?!

The beauty of therapy work is that it is forever and ongoing. Unlike the show ring, there is no 'shelf-life' or 'retirement plan' for these dogs. I heard of a therapy dog that had shared himself his whole life and when diagnosed with cancer, the dog continued to work. His owner stated that she wasn't sure who was getting or giving the therapy...he lived and died a therapy dog and gave and received comfort in his final days.

I hope this is something I am able to do for a long, long time and I hope my daughter will continue with this throughout her life. It's important to think of others and this is a great avenue to personal growth for McKenna. She has always been a very strong young lady and I am proud of her and admire her courage. She is a better person than me. Balancing school, exams, her grooming business--and now there is talk about getting a 'real' job at the vet clinic now that she is of age, this volunteering commitment takes an enormous amount of time and dedication--and Hospice work can be very emotionally draining. I am pleased she values the importance of volunteer work and I see her making it a priority in her life.

Would I recommend Pet Therapy to others? Absolutely! That 'do-good' endorphin fills every cell of your body and, like an addiction, leaves you wanting more. If you have a KBT that has a personality to share, look into a program in your hometown. You'll be glad you did!

This award recognizes the canine-humanitarian contribution to society and the individual through the following award categories:

#### 1. Category 1 Service Dog:

Service or assistance dogs are trained to assist individuals with meeting special needs on a daily basis; these needs can be physical, psychological and/or emotional; examples include hearing, sight service dogs and alert response dogs who alert their human companions to seizures and other medical emergencies;

#### 2. Category 2 Therapy Dog:

Therapy dogs are trained to provide care and comfort to patients and residents in medical care facilities, retirement communities and shelters; Examples include retirement communities; senior centers; veterans homes, military hospitals; healthcare facilities, hospitals, hospice and medical care facilities; children's hospitals, rehabilitation centers such as shelters for homeless, battered women and children; military and veterans hospitals and recovery centers;

#### 3. Category 3 Educational Service Dog (Therapy Dog):

Educational Service Dog works with children in public and private schools in academic and special needs areas; Programs can include but are not limited to the Bite Avoidance programs in schools and organizations such as The Boys and Girls Clubs; Canine-Assisted Reading Programs; Safety School Crossing Program; Programs include Kerries teaching children how to interact with dogs and build a positive relationship with dogs;

#### 4. Category 4 Exemplary Companion Dog /Act of Exemplary Performance:

The Exemplary Companion Dog is the Kerry who has performed a one time event of an exemplary act, contributed to others or a Kerry who has exhibited companionship to an individual under exemplary circumstances (Example: saving family members from a fire in the home or acted as a companion to a person who is terminally ill;) Other examples of exemplary performance include Kerries who serve in search and rescue, or work with firefighters and police in security and rescue.

#### Award Criteria:

- The dog must be a purebred Kerry Blue Terrier;
- 2. The dog must be nominated by a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition; the owner(s) of the dog does not need to be a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition;
- Through 2012, AKC and other certification registry requirements for the applicant are waived; after
  which a minimum of AKC-PAL registration will be required; additional requirements for certification
  may be added per award category, as necessary.

#### Award:

- Each qualified recipient who contributes in one area receives a Level I Certificate and Medallion;
- Each qualified recipient who contributes in two areas receives a Level II Certificate and Medallion;
- Each qualified recipient who contributes in three areas or more receives a Level III Certificate and Medallion

#### Recognition:

Each recipient will be recognized in Blueprints; on the USKBTC website, and also at their specialty of choice, if desired and requested.





#### Tally Ho! The New AKC Coursing Ability Test

Imagine being able to take your Kerry to a wide open field, remove his leash and collar, and allow him to chase things to his heart's content...without any concerns about running afoul of leash laws, irate property owners, other loose dogs, or cars. Now imagine earning qualifying ribbons and titles if your dog is good at it...with no formal training required. That's the *allure* of lure coursing!

Lure coursing is primarily a sport for sighthounds—breeds such as the Greyhound, Saluki, and Whippet that have been bred for and used to run down game for their handlers for thousands of years. Beginning in the late 1800's, coursing began to evolve from a purely practical application to a competitive sport, first in enclosed areas with live game and then, starting in the 1920's, the circular racetrack format with a mechanical rabbit that is still done with Greyhounds and Whippets today. Then, in the 1970's, a California sighthound breeder by the name of Lyle Gillette came up with the idea of running a mechanical lure in an open field using an arrangement of pulleys and string to pull an artificial lure around a course. This system allowed operators both to easily vary the distance and design of the courses, and to simulate the sudden twists and turns of live prey. Thus, modern lure coursing as we know it was born. It was approved as an AKC performance event in 1991, with participation and titles limited only to breeds classified as sighthounds.

But the instinct to give chase is present to varying degrees in all dogs, not just sighthounds, and while some organizations, such as the Jack Russell Terrier Club of America, offer similar events, most breeds were still excluded from participating. According to long-time Greyhound owner and breeder Laurel Drew of Albuquerque, lure coursing clubs started allowing other breeds to try their skills at running after the lure, purely for fun, and some of these clubs would award hand-lettered certificates for dogs that successfully completed the course. The-



se events proved to be tremendously popular, and based on this interest, the AKC launched the Coursing Ability Test (CAT), as a titling event for all dogs, in February of 2011. By the end of the year, 412 dogs

from 90 breeds (including 2 Kerry Blue Terriers) and mixes had already earned the basic Coursing Ability title (CA, awarded for successfully completing 3 runs), along with 25 Coursing Ability Advanced titles (CAA, 10 runs), and 1 Coursing Ability Excellent title (CAX, 25 runs).

My first experience with lure coursing was in January of this year when I let "the boys," my Kerry, Remi, and my daughter's Papillon, Ripley, try a "Lure for a Cure" fun course that was set up at the Paws for Wishes events in Tempe, AZ, where we were competing in the AKC agility trials. That was a short rectangular course enclosed by orange plastic fencing, and it included a series of 3 "jump bumps" and a low tire jump for the dogs to negotiate. It looked like a lot of fun, and since the proceeds were going to canine cancer research, I purchased tickets for three runs and brought Remi and Ripley over after we

were finished with agility for the day. I figured Remi would be interested, but to my amazement both boys went absolutely berserk when they saw the lure (a piece of rabbit fur) moving, lung-



ing and screaming like a pair of teenage girls catching sight of Justin Bieber! I let Ripley go first, and he took off like a shot, covering the course faster than many of the larger dogs. Remi went next and had an equally grand time. I let Ripley have the third and final run I paid for, since a friend of mine wanted to videotape him for Meghan, who is a college student and couldn't attend those trials (*The video, which shows both Remi and Ripley, can be viewed on YouTube, under "NMKerryBlue"*). The spectators seemed to enjoy themselves as much as the dogs, laughing and cheering at all the dogs' attempts to get the lure!

So I was very excited to see that the Albuquerque Whippet Fanciers Association was holding AKC coursing tests in Moriarty, 30 miles east of Albuquerque, in March over Meghan's spring break, and immediately entered both boys in the coursing ability tests.

The trials were in an open cattle pasture (short grass prairie) over very uneven terrain, and the course was much longer than the fun course we did in January: 600 yards for most dogs, though dogs shorter than 12" and brachycephalic breeds only have to cover half that. In order to qualify, the dogs have to chase the lure (3 highly visible plastic garbage bags that are fastened to the line) continuously, and finish the 600 yard course in 2 minutes or less (1.5 minutes for the 300 yard course). Competitors are required to check in at a designated time before each test, so that all the dogs can be examined, both to determine that they are fit to run, and that there are no bitches in season. Just like in Arizona, Remi and Ripley started barking and lunging as soon as they saw the lure and heard the motor that pulls it around the course. Remi was one of the first dogs to go on all his runs (two each day), and quick-

ly settled into an easy extended gallop that kept him within striking distance of the lure. He finished strongly, with energy to spare, on each of his runs, though he had little interest in the lure once it stopped moving. However, I had to get his collar and lead back on quickly as he was still fresh enough each time to want to go after the lure again as soon as he saw it moving into position for the next dog!



One of the trial workers told me that terriers tend to do very well at lure coursing, since they are the only dogs besides sighthounds that were bred to go after game and actually dispatch it. And I could

see differences in how different breeds/groups handled the lure. Remi, a Sealyham Terrier, and a wonderful pair of WFTs from California ran the most like the sighthounds, very intently focused on the lure itself and running the same path as the lure. A Doberman and a couple of German Pinschers had similar running styles, and I have to wonder if this has something to do with the fact that "pinscher" is the German word for terrier! A Boxer and a pair of Standard Schnauzers did equally well. The herding breeds also did very well, but tended to run much wider and cut the orners, like they were trying to head off or "gather" the lure. A friend's Beagle easily passed three of his runs, but stopped cold partway through one to follow an interesting scent. Among the Spitz or Nordic type breeds, a Eurasier (a FSS breed originally developed from a Wolfspitz/ Chow cross) showed no interest at all in chasing the lure, though two Samoyeds managed to qualify with somewhat lackluster runs. As for Ripley (the lone toy dog in the tests), he started off great each time, ran intently for about 50 yards or so, and then stopped and returned to Meghan. Meghan and I figured that this was because Ripley, perhaps being aware of the fact that he only weighs 8 pounds and is therefore quite vulnerable to an attack by coyotes or other predators, did not want to go too far away from the relative safety of Meghan's side. Another possibility for Ripley's behavior is that since Papillons are toy spaniels, he figured his job was done once he chased the lure away, or "flushed" it. But since Ripley had so much fun and seemed very pleased with himself, we didn't tell him he was supposed to keep chasing the lure!

The best part about the lure coursing for me was seeing how much fun the dogs were having. There's no training required (though a fit dog is a must, as is some basic off-lead control so you can catch your dog after the run)—for dogs that have the instinct, lure coursing is an event that allows a dog to just enjoy being a dog. I plan to keep entering Remi in local coursing ability tests not to earn additional titles so much as to treat

him to an occasional weekend where he can bark his head off and run flat out. You all have GOT to try this with your dogs!



Master Harrison is a funny guy. While at the shows, he's a practical joker and can set aside his pride and




image for a good laugh, yet, in the ring, he is all business. Harrison is a true competitor and is always up for a

(Although I have done everything humanly possible to prevent runaway arrows, I have a feeling I will be getting to know my neighbors a bit better!)

Having just turned twelve, he will return to the ring as an Open Intermediate junior, which in the south, tends to have the highest class entry. He will have to practice and get his head back in the game again. He received his invitation to compete at Eukanuba 2012, so between now and then, he will be cheering for his sister in hopes she, too, will qualify this year.

If you see Harrison at the shows, be looking for 'Mr. Bow-Tie Man' --you'll know him when you see him in the ring, or, he'll be on the hunt for a good raffle table!





Two such products are "Nature's Miracle Skunk Odor Remover" by Nature's Miracle, and "Skunk Off" by Thornwell Corporation.

#### Some suggestions for bathing a dog who has skunk odor:

Before handling your dog, you may want to change your clothes. Skunk spray is very difficult to remove from clothing. Cover the dog's bed with something to protect it. Leaving the dog outdoors for a while will greatly reduce the odor.

Determine where the spray hit the dog. Depending on your dog's hair type, you may be able to trim away or comb out some of the affected hair.

When you're ready to wash the dog, only clean the sprayed area. Skunk spray is oily and can easily be spread all over the dog. Since you will likely have to repeat the procedure, save an all-over bath until the second or third washing.

#### Editor's Note:

In a recent article (December 2003) of "Your Dog" newsletter published by Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine, they suggested a safe home treatment for de-skunking your dog.

Wash the dog with the following mixture: One-fourth of a cup of baking soda One teaspoon of liguid soap One quart of hydrogen peroxide

Blueprints Editor's Note: I have personally used the mixture recommended by Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine, and can report that it worked well for us.



The mission of this awards program is to recognize the versatility of the Kerry Blue Terrier and recognize United States Kerry Blue Terrier members and their dogs upon achieving titles in more than one discipline of competition. Current USKBTC membership is necessary to be eligible for this awards program.

List of Disciplines eligible for awards:

AKC Agility Title
AKC Conformation Title

Earth Dog/Hunting Title: Hunting Certificate (HC) awarded by American Working Terrier Association

Herding Trial Dog Title: AKC Herding Tested (HT) or Pre-Trial Tested (PT), or Herding Capability Title (HCT) awarded by American Herding Breeds Association

AKC Obedience Title (CD or higher)

AKC Tracking Title

AKC Rally Title

Wild Card: A performance title from a discipline not otherwise listed may be used for one of the seven award levels, subject to approval. Examples include Flyball, Canine Nosework, AKC Coursing Ability, or Dock Dog.

Eligible dogs will be submitted for award(s) by owner(s) in the following manner: Properly filled in application including:

Enclosure of photocopies of title certificates (normally non-AKC) if needed for verification.

Enclosure of comments or brief biography of dog's accomplishments which will be published in the Blueprints (subject to editing) along with award presented, including name of owner(s) and breeder(s). Photos sent by owner for inclusion in Blueprints will be printed subject to room available.

Award applications will be accepted within the following fiscal year time period: August 1 to July 31.Members will submit applications during this time period. Those applications received after July 31st will normally be held over for the next year for qualification and presentation. Award presentation will be made at the Annual General Meeting in October (Montgomery County). Awards not presented at the AGM will be mailed to recipients.

ACTUAL AWARD: The award will be a certificate suitable for framing signed by the president of the club and Versatility committee representative to include the following information:

The name: United States Kerry Blue Terrier Club Versatility Award

The name of the Award tier (see below)

The registered name of the dog (with all titles, as the owner wishes it to appear on award)

The name of the owner(s) of record (at least ONE owner must be a current USKBTC member)

The date the Award is presented

ONE certificate will be presented per dog for each award tier.

A keepsake memento commemorating the award will be awarded at the club's discretion.

#### Award tier structure is as follows:

The Bronze Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in two different disciplines.

The Silver Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in three different disciplines.

The Gold Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in four different disciplines.

The Platinum Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in five different disciplines.

The Emerald Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in six different disciplines. The Diamond Award is presented to the Kerry Blue Terrier earning titles in seven different disciplines.

\* Please Note: Canine Good Citizen (CGC), Temperament Testing (TT), and Therapy Dog International (TDI) along with other therapy or service dog certifications are not considered competitive titles. Therefore they do not qualify as eligible disciplines for these awards. These certifications may however be included in the dog's name as stated on a Versatility Award should the owner wish them. The owner is responsible for submitting the dog's name as it should appear on the award. Members wanting their Kerries' therapy or service dog accomplishments recognized are encouraged to apply for the USKBTC's "Kerry It Forward" awards.

Additional Notes: The accomplishment of any of these disciplines may take more than one fiscal year to achieve. Therefore the applicant may submit an application along with proof of awards at any time provided that the owner submits the application by the stated deadline to qualify for that year's award presentations. A separate award and certificate will be awarded for each additional discipline tier achieved no matter what time frame is required to achieve that award. Example: Dog A is already a Ch., CDX, TD. Therefore he will immediately qualify under (3) disciplines (conformation, obedience, tracking) making the dog eligible to receive (2) awards (Bronze and Silver) from the club. To recognize those members who have achieved multiple disciplines in the past with their dogs, awards will be offered to eligible title holders (with proper application and proof of title) retroactive back to and including the year 1995. All titles (as listed above) earned are eligible for tier qualification provided that dog earned at least ONE discipline title after 1995.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. A notice of your application will be published in the next Quarterly issue of the official Club publication, BLUEPRINTS.
- 2. Thirty (30) days after publication in BLUEPRINTS, your application and any member's comments will be submitted to the Board of Governors for consideration.
- 3. You will be promptly notified, in writing, of the Board's action.
- 4. You will be provided with a copy of the approved Constitution and Bylaws.

This Membership process can take up to six (6) months or more, due to the Quarterly publication of BLUEPRINTS, please be patient. Note that your check may be cashed prior to your being elected to membership. This does not automatically elect you to membership. If for any reason, you are not elected to membership; your application fee will be refunded.

This document defines the ethical standards to which we ascribe as a condition of membership in the United Stated Kerry Blue Terrier Club (USKBTC). Membership is a privilege conferred by the Board of Governors, acting for the Membership, upon those individuals who meet the high standards set forth in the Club Constitution and Bylaws and this Code. As members, we are individually charged with complying with this code and demanding similar compliance of all other members. We must hold the interest of the Kerry Blue Terrier superior to our own in exercising the responsibilities that accompany the privileges of membership.

#### I. RESPONSIBILITIES AS A MEMBER

- Members of the USKBTC, as Stewards to the breed, have the obligation to protect and serve the best interests of the Kerry Blue Terrier at all times. A member's every action should reflect credit on themselves, the USKBTC and, above all, the Kerry Blue Terrier.
- > The approved standard for the breed is the fundamental imperative guiding our actions. Members have the obligation to protect and serve these standards as a condition of membership.
- Members must be familiar with and comply with the rules of the American Kennel Club (AKC); the Constitution and By-laws of the USKBTC; and (as appropriate) the rules established by any member club of the USKBTC.

- Members will observe the highest standards of conduct and sportsmanship at all times. Whether as a breeder, exhibitor, or spectator, they shall conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the Kerry Blue Terrier, dogs in general, and the sport of showing dogs.
- Members shall maintain the highest standards of health and sanitation for their own Kerry Blue Terriers, as well as for any other animals in their possession or entrusted to their care. They shall demand the same high standards of others, members and non-members alike.

#### II. RESPONSIBILITIES AS A BREEDER

#### A Breeder shall:

- Be guided at all times by the approved standard for the Kerry Blue Terrier and shall consider breeding only those specimens that conform to the standard.
- When contemplating breeding a litter or providing the services of a stud dog, strive toward maintaining breed type and producing dogs of exceptional quality, temperament, and condition. Breeding or supporting breeding to a lesser standard is not acceptable.
- Use for breeding only those dogs that are healthy and free from serious congenital and hereditary defects. Refrain from further use, any bitch or stud dog that has developed such a health problem or produced any serious inherited defects detrimental to the offspring and the overall well being of the breed.
- Not use a bitch for breeding prior to reaching eighteen (18) months of age (preferably 24 months) or older than eight (8) years of age. A bitch should not be bred more than two (2) out of three (3) consecutive heat cycles, nor produce more than five (5) litters in her lifetime. Recognizing the variations in heat cycles and sizes of litters, valid exceptions may exist, however it is incumbent on the breeder to exercise good judgment in exercising such exceptions.
- Not sell puppies to pet shops either outright or on consignment; supply puppies for auctions, raffles, or other such activities; refrain from selling to persons whose intention (either known or suspected) is to resell or use the puppy in a breeding program not complying with this code of ethics. The breeder shall ensure that the prospective buyer is prepared to provide the same degree of care required of members of the USKBTC. The Code of Ethics should be provided and discussed with potential buyers as part of a thorough screening process. All buyers should be encouraged to become members of the USKBTC and member clubs.
- Promptly apply for AKC registration of the litter. Puppies should not be sold prior to reaching ten (10) weeks of age (preferably 12 weeks). The sale of every dog shall include a signed registration or registration application (Blue Slip), and a four-generation pedigree. Any exceptions to these requirements, or valid restrictions or limitations imposed as conditions to the sale (e.g., no breeding) must be agreed to in writing by both parties at the time of sale. It is strongly recommended that a written agreement accompany all sales. Buyers should be provided with assistance and support in the setting of ears and in learning proper grooming. If the buyer is not located in the same area, the breeder should make arrangements with another USKBTC member in that area to assist the new owner.
- Provide with each sale, a record of dated and types of immunization given, immunizations required, and veterinary health records. Instructions should be provided, preferably in writing, on diseases and hereditary factors related to the breed, proper medical care, feeding, and grooming. Providing a copy of the current USKBTC Handbook represents a means of conveying this type of information, and is a sound investment on the part of the breeder. No puppy should be sold without either temporary or permanent protection against distemperhepatitis and parvo. Puppies should have a veterinary examination, and worming if required, before sale.
- Maintain accurate and complete records of stock, matings, pedigrees, show records, and transfers. Breeders are responsible for conducting research on their pedigrees to ensure correct ancestry, accurate spelling of names and correct registration numbers. Breeders should be familiar with and comply with all record keeping requirements required by the AKC. Litter registration applications must be correct and promptly requested. Individual puppy registration should be completed in a timely manner.
- Shall not engage in false or misleading advertising or other misrepresentations with respect to their own breeding. They shall not malign others by making false or misleading statements regarding another member's dogs, breeding practices, or person. Advertising should not be worded to attract undesirable buyers nor encourage raising dogs for profit.
- Consider the growing problems related to excess dogs ending up in animal shelters and should exercise sound judgment and prudent restraint in their breeding programs. Litters should be limited to numbers that are consistent with achieving a sound breeding program and the best interests of the Kerry Blue Terrier.
- Be prepared to assume lifetime responsibility for any litter produced.

#### III. RESPONSIBILITIES AS AN EXHIBITOR OR HANDLER

- Act professionally at all times in caring for and exhibiting any dog in your charge.
- Do not engage in any questionable contact with judges prior to exhibiting under them.
- Comply with AKC Rules and Regulations for Dog Shows, Obedience Trials, Field Trials, and The Guidelines for Dog Show Judges.
- Exhibit or handle only those dogs that conform as closely as possible to the approved standard.
- Do not indulge in the practice of making "kennel majors", or exhibiting filler dogs that they know themselves to be unworthy of championships, for the purpose of finishing dogs. Such practices lessen the meaning and value of a championship and do not serve the breed.

#### IV. ENFORCEMENT

- The USKBTC expects adherence to this Code of Ethics and blatant disregard of these standards will not be condoned. Violations of the standards are not in the best interests of the Club or the breed. Such behavior can serve as a cause of imposing discipline or terminating membership if charges are brought before the Board of Governors in accordance with the procedures as defined in Article VI (Discipline) of the USKBTC Constitution and Bylaws.
- Article VI addresses the specific procedures for proffering charges; the hearing process; and the rights of the parties involved. Each member is expected to be fully familiar with this very important provision of the By-laws.
